Point Cost	Benefit	Limited?	Detailed Description
1 pt	Raffle tickets	No	If you want to increase foot, we'll give you raffle tickets to hand out to attendees that stop by. These will be used at the end of the event for a raffle of some amazing prizes provided by the conference.
1 pt	Attendee name/ email list (opt -in)	No	Do you want contact information from everyone that registered and opted in? We ask that you limit your bulk emails to one message.
3 pts	Booth	No	We'll give you a space in a high-traffic part of the conference to host your booth. We provide the table, you set it up however you want. You can bring 2 non-attendee booth staff.
3 pts	Naming of a session room	Yes	We'll put your name and logo on a room. The room will be referred to as the "Your Company" Room on all conference materials.
3 pts	2 workshop tickets	Yes	A great way to get team member into a pre-conference day-long workshop of their choice, depending on availability (Friday only).
3 pts	Block of 5 tickets	Yes	A great way to get your whole team in to the conference before tickets even go on sale (Saturday only).
3 pts	Sponsor scholarships	Yes	Sponsor up to 7 college student tickets or 3 tickets for anyone who applies for a scholarship due to financial need.
4 pts	Guaranteed speaker	Yes	Want to make sure you get a speaker into the conference. We can offer a very limited number of slots to speakers with pre-approved content. Apply early to guarantee a spot! No longer available after CFP closes.
4 pts	Opening or closing address	Yes	Want a few minutes to talk to all the attendees at the beginning or end of the conference? We'll give you up to 5 minutes to talk about whatever is most important for you to share with attendees.
4 pts	2 VIP party tickets and address	Yes	How about a few minutes to talk to all the speakers organizers, and other VIPs are the event? We'll give you up to 5 minutes to talk about whatever is most important for you to share.
10 pts	Naming rights to diversity mixer	Yes	Your name and logo on all materials related to our pre-conference diversity mixer, referred to as being "Sponsored by [Your Company]" on all conference materials. Ideal if you can also host the event.
